Critical Strategies for Ecological Architectures Mathias Rollot, 2025-11-01 This book addresses the alarming state of the planet and considers a potential new role for architecture in the Anthropocene It explores ways in which architecture could contribute to solutions as well as how the discipline should

prepare for the future Drawing on other disciplines such as bioregionalism animalism and decolonial thinking it demonstrates how architecture can extend its relevance The book introduces new theoretical approaches that encourage completely different ways of thinking showing and designing It introduces concepts such as human energy decolonial bioregionalism and emancipatory architecture which serve to challenge anthropocentric theories and promote more sustainable architectural practices This book makes an ethical appeal to architects and non architects alike proposing new strategies for thinking teaching and creating a wholly different kind of architecture for a rapidly changing world In doing so it addresses the challenges facing contemporary societies and ecological changes demonstrating how the ecological humanities can transform architecture as a field and radically alter its history references values and aims The book aims to contribute to a metamorphosis of architecture towards greater ecological and emancipatory capacity and towards pluriversal bioregions

The Architecture of Disability David Gissen, 2023-01-24 A radical critique of architecture that places disability at the heart of the built environment Disability critiques of architecture usually emphasize the need for modification and increased access but *The Architecture of Disability* calls for a radical reorientation of this perspective by situating experiences of impairment as a new foundation for the built environment With its provocative proposal for the construction of disability this book fundamentally reconsiders how we conceive of and experience disability in our world Stressing the connection between architectural form and the capacities of the human body David Gissen demonstrates how disability haunts the history and practice of architecture Examining various historic sites landscape designs and urban spaces he deconstructs the prevailing functionalist approach to accommodating disabled people in architecture and instead asserts that physical capacity is essential to the conception of all designed space By recontextualizing the history of architecture through the discourse of disability *The Architecture of Disability* presents a unique challenge to current modes of architectural practice theory and education Envisioning an architectural design that fully integrates disabled persons into its production it advocates for looking beyond traditional notions of accessibility and shows how certain incapacities can offer us the means to positively reimagine the roots of architecture

Decoloniality in the Break of Global Blackness Michaeline A. Crichlow, Patricia M. Northover, 2025-05-21 This book contextualized by the violence of globalization investigates the fungible fugitive and untenable experiences of Black being and time through a decolonial poethics of global Blackness In so doing it introduces innovative readings of coloniality decoloniality by threading its meaning and movement through the problem of Blackness It argues that global Blackness is the complexly entangled other side of decoloniality as movement method and poethics for radical new worlds The essays explore this through inter transdisciplinary creative and decolonial standpoints whether from prison abolitionist demands to Afrofuturist imaginaries or by seeing through Black mirrors It emphasizes the paradoxical characteristics of global Blackness its spectral quality of being in and out of modernity's self narrative to provide a way of dwelling with global Blackness as a force that is neither properly constituted by corporeality nor thinkable in ontological

terms determined by modern power The book will be of interest to academics researchers and students in the fields of social sciences cultural studies postcolonial studies as well as cultural practitioners art educators artists cultural activists and those institutions that seek to decolonize imaginaries thought practices and methods Given its diverse offerings it will also be of interest to upper level undergraduates graduate students and academics

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
